

Medicines

ANSM's scope of action covers the different categories of medicines (proprietary, generic, biosimilar, herbal medicines, homoeopathy, etc.) available on the market for adults and the paediatric population.

In the development of a medicine, ANSM is involved from the clinical trial phase. It subsequently grants, at a national level, a marketing <u>authorisation</u> (MA) based on the assessment of the benefits and risks of the medicine, and continues to ensure the <u>surveillance</u> of its safety in use. Additionally, ANSM regulates the <u>advertising</u> off these health products aimed at the public and healthcare professionals.
